

Be Strong in THE LORD

“Be Strong in THE LORD and in The Power of HIS Might” Ephesians 6:10. It is better translated: “Be ye strengthened in THE LORD and in The Power of HIS Might. Note The Difference. The Second, the better, truer translation to The Original, The first term: Be ye =you strengthened, is in the passive; which means that the disciple, you, the believer, receives the action; thus you yield. Yield to THE HOLY SPIRIT. Yield to The Infilling of GOD, daily, continually, in every way. It is an imperative action. Is a command of The One - here, making It. Thus, in the greek, this word is in the present tense, the passive voice and the imperative mood. This again is saying: IT must be done continually, now, ongoing. Then, in the passive, you yield to the action of GOD, receive the action, say ‘yes’ in your soul, say “yes” in your heart, say “yes” in your spirit, then say “yes” with your lips. Seal it. Live by it. Live through it, so you can live more. It is imperative that you do it. Do it now, from now on.




The Heart of The Matter

Be ye strengthened

“Be ye strengthened”... from Ephesians 6:10. We need to be strong: strong in body, strong in mind, strong in heart. The one that faints in the day of battle, their strength is small. Proverbs 24:10. We must go from strength to strength, growing in strength, always with an indomitable will, all found in, made alive by, and continually drawn from THE LORD. We yield, we yield to GOD, we yield to THE LORD. The only obstacle in an ultimate sense is you, both our ignorance, and our arrogance. Arrogance; that self-oriented, defiance, flouting oneself before others, is unnecessary and a spiritual roadblock: destroy it with GOD, forever. Ignorance has a simple but profound cure: knowledge. The Whole Verse is: “Do not be drunk with wine, for that is debauchery, but be filled with THE SPIRIT.” You and I will be filled with something, why not be properly filled with SOMEONE: WHO IS GOD; THE HOLY SPIRIT. Yield, now, every moment, ongoing, yielding to THE INFILLING of GOD by THE SPIRIT, THE HOLY ONE: *now*.

Strength is measured in different ways. One of the lesser known but no less important is in wisdom. Let's look to Proverbs 24:5: "A wise man is strong, a man of knowledge increases strength." So we note some interesting things. First, *in the first clause*, a man here is a Gever = a he-man. A strong man.

A strong man is wise in the strength (*literal translation*). *The second half of The Verse says: A Man of knowledge is increasingly strengthening strength.* (*Literal translation*). *This is a phenomenal Verse, well-worth re-visiting time and again. True strength of this order is truly strong in ways we pray you come to find out.*

Your Hebrew Lesson

What does The word To know mean in Hebrew? It is very interesting. To know: Lada'at; is a powerful word, and it indicates at the basic level; to know by experience. The Lamed, The First Letter, indicates the infinitive form, which

is timeless, genderless, and numberless. The root Word is: Da'at: formed by The Hebrew Letters: Dalet-Ayin-Taw/Tav. It basically means: The Door of and The Path to seeing and understanding The Covenant of The Cross! This is power-

ful!. This is life-transforming! It is The True Purpose of Knowledge; not just an accumulation of facts and figures, but GOD Knowledge is: The Door to and The Path of seeing and understanding The Covenant of The Cross!

What do you say when

someone says that 'you don't know what you're talking about!'"? Just continue, and make a suggestive but passing comment that, when he/she 'hears you out', till the end, it will make a lot more sense, if they would but give themselves the opportunity to learn something new. And if I'm wrong, I would really ap-

preciate their insight and help to correct the matter. We can work together; learn from each other, educate each other, point out potential blind spots in each other's thinking, and do it in a manner that is commendable, CHRIST-like, un-offensive, and steady, anchored in CHRIST, not swayed but another's opinion, degree,

brashness, rudeness, or un-kind manners. We are the light of the world, Matthew 5:15. You must shine your light in such a way that men may see your good works and glorify your FATHER WHO is in heaven. You have been positioned in a place/s where light is dark, and light is foreign. Good. Now Light it up.
