

The Name of the Lord

The name Mareh=Lord, used of GOD in The Old Testament=Tanach, is used of JESUS by the early Church, and it's Biblical:

LORD = MAREH = מַרְהַ

Aramaic Dead Sea Scrolls, according to good scholarship, has verified that *marana tha* means "LORD, come." Paul's use of the Aramaic form indicates that the early Jewish Christians prayed to CHRIST JESUS as GOD. They looked for HIS Coming, not THE FATHER, cf. Acts3:19-20.

In Daniel 2:47, MAREH is rendered Lord:

The king answered unto Daniel, and said, Of a truth [it is], that your God [is] a God of gods, and a Lord (MAREH) of kings, and a revealer of secrets, seeing thou could reveal this secret.

In Daniel 5:23, again, MAREH is rendered Lord:

But hast lifted up thyself against the Lord(MAREH) of heaven; and they have brought the vessels of his house before thee, and thou, and thy lords, thy wives, and thy concubines, have drunk wine in them; and thou hast praised the gods of silver, and gold, of brass, iron, wood, and stone, which see not, nor hear, nor know: and the God in whose hand thy breath [is], and whose [are] all thy ways, hast thou not glorified:

1 Corinthians 16:22

If any man love not the Lord Jesus Christ, let him be accursed=Anathema Marana tha.

Rev 22:20

He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus.

Contrary to the skeptics, and those who are willingly ignorant of The Jewish literature with respect to this term, The Term MAREH was used of GOD, THE LORD, both in The Bible, in the Dead Sea Scrolls and in The Didache.
